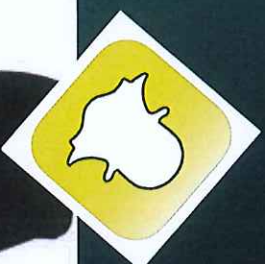

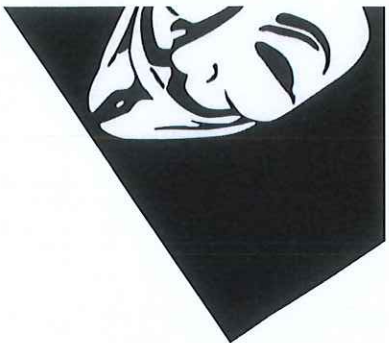
Blocking someone could defiantly help especially if it is a adult! Would you say it to someone's face? No?

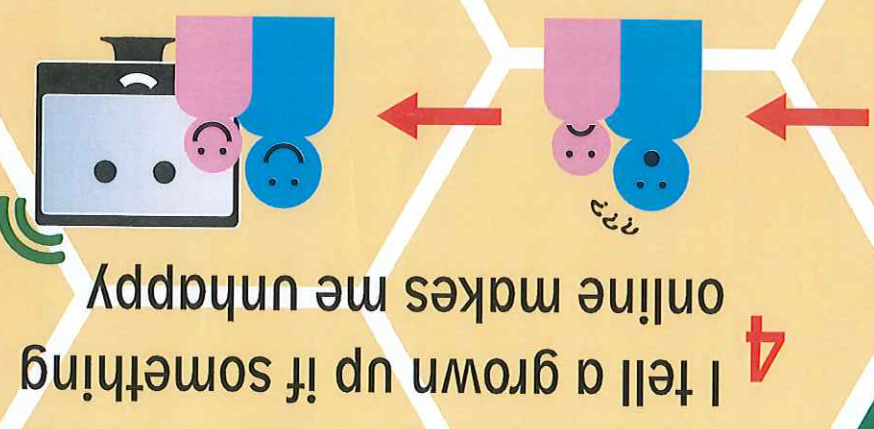

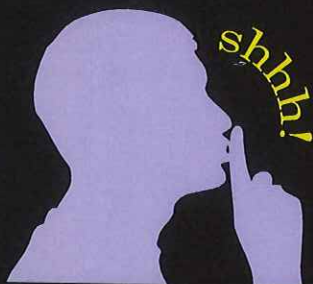

I am aware that copyright laws exist.

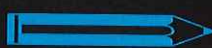
I know that my online actions may have offline consequences.
